Outerlimits Sets SV Single Kilo Record

Tuesday, April 29th, 2014

WASHINGTON, N.C.—With passes of 100.365 mph and 101.311 mph during a "special event" kilo run, Brian Forehand set a new kilometer top-speed record of **100.840 mph** on the Pamlico River in Washington, N.C. The record was set in a canopied Outerlimits SV 29' (owned by offshore racer Michael "Doc" Janssen) powered by a single 525HP engine, and running a **6-blade Hering propeller**.

The record was sanctioned, recorded and verified by the American Power Boat Association. "We are calling it the 'SV Single' special event kilo record because it was set in an Outerlimits SV 29," said Mark Wheeler, the APBA president.
