



NEW WORLD RECORD  
**180.47 mph**



Officially the World's Fastest V-Bottom

Tuesday, April 29th, 2014

**WASHINGTON, N.C.**—With passes of 179.500 mph and 181.422 mph during a "special event" kilo run, Brian Forehand and Joe Sgro eclipsed the V-bottom kilo record in a 43-foot Outerlimits owned by Sgro and powered by twin 1650HP engines and running forged **6-blade Hering propellers** to a stunning **180.470 mph**.

The record was sanctioned, recorded and verified by the **American Power Boat Association**. Today's efforts by the Outerlimits team eclipsed the existing kilo mark of 171.88 mph set by Reggie Fountain and Ben Robertson in a 42-foot Fountain V-bottom in 2004 which was also propelled by forged **6 blade Hering propellers**.
